There will be an alternative available if you wish your Easter offering to go to the church as usual for cash collections.

Followed by: 'A Gethsemane Vigil' from 7.00pm 10pm. to share the story of Holy week as we read from "First Easter" by Peter Marshall with times of silence and reflective music, holding the suffering of our world in prayer.
- \*Easter Day (Sunday) Morning Sunrise at Cronk ny aree Laa. Meeting at 5.30am: a silent Vigil as the sun rises, followed by a short time of Celtic prayer and song before we share breakfast together on the hilltop.
