*Following on from the visit of the Archbishop of York, 'The Lord's Prayer Exhibition' is on daily from 9.00am - 5.30pm at the cathedral. It includes a Soundscape which lasts about 1 hour 30 mins. This has the Lord's Prayer in many languages spoken by migrants to the Isle of Man who come from 172 countries. The Lord's Prayer is also sung and discussed. There are banners around the Cathedral which accompany this.
