A message from Bishop Tricia concerning the recent Tynwald vote....

*A letter from the Bishop is printed off and available in church. It refers to the recent decision within Tynwald to proceed and strip the Bishop of a vote. In Westminster there are 26 Bishops in the House of Lords that vote, representing a population of 70 million. Here on the island, with a small population of just 84,000, our Parliament wishes to remove the one vote. Bishop Tricia may well be the last Bishop of the Diocese of Sodor and Man, and the Diocese subsumed into a larger English Diocese, bringing to an end over 1,000 yrs of an Episcopal head on this Island.
